Dear Parents

Keeping in view the safety and security of our students, we at DAV Public School NTPC, follow various safety measures and share guidelines with the students. We also seek your cooperation for making the students more aware to be safe and secure.

Following are some safety rules you must guide your child to follow at school and society -

- Ensure that your child wears School I-Card daily and remembers his/ her full name , address , parent's name / contact number and the emergency phone numbers to reach out any kind of need.
- Guide your child to be aware of strangers and never accept food /any edible item from them . He/she must not share his/her personal details with anyone such as -school's name , residential address and the contact number .
- Train and guide your child on how to respond to an emergency . We at DAV NTPC keep on conducting school training programmes regularly such as Fire safety Mockdrill and Disaster management drill for our students.
- Your child may be given a dare by friends to do something dangerous in school or outside school . Explain him/her that he /she should never do something that makes him/her feel uncomfortable or causes physical , mental or emotional harm. Also teach and guide him/ her to resist peer pressure.
- Train and guide your child the difference between safe and unsafe touches , as soon as he /she can understand the concept. If he /she has been touched without his/her consent , then he/she should report it immediately to the teacher or the parent .
- Please guide your child on responsible mobile and social media use, emphasizing cyber safety and protocols. Ensure that he/she does not share any photos ,videos and personal information on social networking sites.
- Also ask him/her to refuse to follow anyone to be it a teacher , staff member , or fellow student to secluded areas in school like washrooms , deserted part of the schoolyard , or an empty corridor or a classroom. Instruct him/her to always stay in a group.

• Train and guide your child to stand up for him/her self and not succumb to bullying . He/she should respect his/her peers inspite of their differences. If he/ she can't deal with the bully on his/her own . He/ she should approach the person of school counselling cell – Ms. Aarushi Bhatia- 9899161711, Ms. Nishi Arora-9891740741 , Ms. Ambika Sharma - 9811789981.

• Train and guide your child basic rules like : never play or experiment with fire or sharp objects and be careful around loose electrical wires.

• Train and guide him/her on basic road safety rules as in he/she has to walk home from the bus stop alone.

• If your child uses two-wheeler that is suitable for their age group, as per government rules and regulations , he/she must wear helmet and meets the necessary requirements . **School will not be responsible for underage students driving two wheelers/four wheelers for coming to school.**

• Train and guide your child to report immediately to the class teacher if he /she is not feeling well and need any medical supervision. Ask him /her to never ignore any sign of discomfort he/she might be feeling.

• Train and guide your child to never keep any secrets from parents and teachers. Encourage them to talk to you or teachers about anything that is upsetting or making him / her feel uncomfortable. Tell him/ her that no topic is off-limits and parental issues help in getting them resolve faster.

• Explain and guide him/her that he/she should not keep secrets that disturb him/her mental peace or affect him/her emotionally and physically.

• Please be observant and talk to the school or seek expert's help if your child seems withdrawn or is not sleeping or eating properly, it might be a sign of distress. Some of these steps and awareness will ensure safety and avoid any uncomfortable situation in front of our students.

Note:- School will not allow any student to park their private vehicle in school premises that is without the consent of parent , Licence and Helmet . Please ensure to follow the above norms.
